Internet Learning Support Programme – “i Learn at home”

Please be informed that the five-year “i Learn at home” Internet Learning Support Programme (the Programme) was launched to assist needy students to undertake web-based learning at home, by helping them acquire affordable computer and internet access service, and providing them with user and social support. **Families eligible for Internet Access Subsidy disbursed through the Student Financial Assistance Agency (SFAA) or the Comprehensive Social Security Assistance (CSSA) scheme are welcome to join.** Information on the Programme is available at www.ilearnathome.hk.

Two non-profit organisations, namely Hong Kong Council of Social Services and eInclusion Foundation Limited, are implementing the Programme under the brand names of “WebOrganic” and “Net-Com rock n’roll” in the Western and Eastern parts of Hong Kong to provide the following services-

- (a) economical Internet access;
- (b) affordable computer equipment with flexible payment options;
- (c) technical support through hotline and helpdesk;
- (d) training for students;
- (e) training for parents; and
- (f) group based and one-on-one advisory service.

“WebOrganic” covers Central and Western, Islands, Kwai Tsing, Sham Shui Po, Southern, Tsuen Wan, Tuen Mun, Wan Chai, Yau Tsim Mong and Yuen Long; while “Net-Com rock n’ roll” covers Eastern, Kowloon City, Kwun Tong, North, Sai Kung, Sha Tin, Tai Po and Wong Tai Sin.
