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Notes on Picnic for Pupils

A. Before the picnic

1. Wear P.E. uniform.
2. Be environmental friendly.
3. Bring sufficient food and drink.
4. Bring some handkerchiefs, a moist towel and enough clothing.
5. **Do not bring along valuable articles, knives, can-openers or glass-made bottles.**
6. Take breakfast before leaving home, avoid over-eating.
7. Reach school on time. Do not play too much.
8. Label all the coats and belongings (lunch boxes, water bottles ... etc)
9. Bring mosquito repellent, suntan lotion and umbrellas if necessary.

B. Before setting out

1. Queue up quietly for roll call.
2. Get on the coach in an orderly manner. Sit quietly on your seat.

C. During the journey

1. Do not leave your seat while the coach is in motion.
2. Do not eat or drink on the coach.
3. To avoid travel-sickness, you should refrain from eating too much in the morning, taking sweet things or reading books on the coach.

D. On reaching the destination

1. Do not disperse until the teacher has made the roll call.
2. Stay in the park. Do not leave your group without the teacher's permission.
3. Listen carefully to the teacher's instructions and do accordingly.
4. Take good care of your belongings.
5. Keep away from bushes or slopes.
6. **Keep away from animals such as dogs, cats and birds.**
7. **Don't play with water guns.**
8. **Don't hire any bicycles in the park. No cycling in the park.**
9. Put rubbish into the litter-bins.
10. Do not pick flowers or fruit. Keep off the grass.
11. Do not play with fire. No barbecue.

E. On leaving the destination

1. Be aware of the announcement or whistle-call for assembly.
2. Queue up quietly for roll-call.
3. Check all your belongings before you leave.
4. Ensure the place where you stay is clean.

F. After the picnic

1. There will be no post-lesson activities after the picnic.
2. After dismissal, go home straight away. Do not linger about in the streets.

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
